Dear Chair Pingree and Ranking Member Joyce,

In the upcoming Subcommittee on Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2023, I urge you to include \$3,000,000 for the Wasatch Front Water Conservation Effort. The recipient of these funds would be the City of Orem, located at 56 N State Street, Orem, UT 84057. Utah has been experiencing historic droughts, and this multijurisdictional project would help relieve stress on water usage during this period where water is becoming even more scarce of a resource in the West.

This project includes the construction of a 9,000 square foot building that will house three cloth media tertiary filters, chemical storage areas, a 50,000 gallon chlorine contact/storage and equalization tank, reuse pumps and effluent pumps at the OWRP, and 5,000 feet of 12" PVC pipe off-site to the four different water delivery locations. The full design package is 100% complete and construction can commence as soon as funding is in place. Construction should take approximately 9 months.
