I am requesting funding for the Highland Drive Reconstruction and Complete Street Project in fiscal year 2024.


The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Holladay, located at 4580 S 2300 E, Holladay, UT 84117. The funding would be used for a full depth replacement of the existing pavement; addition of sidewalk, bike lanes, transit stops, pedestrian crossings, curb/gutter, xeriscaping and street lighting; improvement of stormwater facilities; and undergrounding of power utilities..

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project is endorsed by the Holladay City Council and supported by two, complete public processes - the Highland Drive Master Plan and Highland Drive Corridor Feasibility Study. It also builds upon a federally-funded Highland Drive Intersections Improvement Project, which addressed pressing, critical safety conditions. Lastly, the project incorporates recommendations from the Holladay General Plan, Holladay Crossroads Small Area Master Plan, Local Link Transit Study, and Mid-Valley Active Transportation Plan.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by under 23 USC 133(b).
