I am requesting funding for the Neffs Canyon Debris Basin Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is Millcreek City located at 3330 S 1300 E, Millcreek, UT 84106.


The funding would be used for mitigating the alluvial fan flood hazards from the FEMA FIRM by constructing debris basin at the apex of the fan, which will collect debris and safely convey the 100-year flood event into a proposed 36" diameter storm drainpipe.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because eliminating the 100-year alluvial fan flood hazards on the FEMA flood insurance rate map would allow the fire station to be remodeled or replaced on the existing fire station site so it can continue to provide needed emergency services.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133), as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
