Dear Chair DeFazio and Ranking Member Graves:

I am requesting funding for the Fort Street reconstruct in surface transportation reauthorization legislation.

The project sponsor for this project is the City of Draper and the project is located on Fort Street (950 E) from 12400 S to 13200 S, Draper 84020.

The funding is designated for the widening of Fort Street from 13200 South to 12400 South. Fort Street is a residential minor collector street that runs through the heart of Draper, with several new schools recently constructed in the surrounding area.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to benefit the infrastructure that Utahns depend on. The planned project will complete curb, gutter, park strips, and sidewalks for the full length. This street is designated as a safe walking route for the surrounding schools, but it lacks sidewalks for much of its length and is in need of drainage improvements. The STP funding for this project is programmed for 2026.
